Report on the audit of the Standalone Annual Financial Results

We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly and year to date standalone annual financial results of Pokarna Limited ('the Company') for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2024 ('the Statement'), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 and 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('the Regulation'), as amended (Listing Regulations).

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid standalone annual financial results:

- (i) is presented in accordance with the requirements of Listing Regulation in this regard; and
- (ii) gives a true and fair view in conformity with the applicable accounting standard, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024.

The Statutory auditors have carried out audit of the above results for the quarter and year ended 31.03.2024 and unmodified report has been issued by them thereon.
- 2) The Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognized accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- 3) The figures of the quarter ended March 31, 2024 and March 31, 2023 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year up to March 31, 2024 and March 31, 2023 respectively and the unaudited published year to date figures up to December 31, 2023 and December 31, 2022 respectively, being the date of the end of the third quarter of the financial year. Also the figures up to the end of the third quarter had only been reviewed and not subjected to audit.
- 4) The Board of Directors in its meeting held on 16th May, 2024 has recommended Equity Dividend @30% i.e. Rs.0.60/- per equity share of Rs.2/- for the financial year 2023-24 (previous year Rs.186.02 lakhs @30% i.e., Rs.0.60 per equity share of Rs.2/- each), subject to requisite approvals. If approved, the dividend would result in a cash outflow of ₹186.02 lakhs.
- 5) 'Other Income' for the year ended 31.03.2024 includes dividend of Rs.417.06 Lakhs (previous year Rs.250.24 Lakhs) and Rs.250.02 Lakhs guarantee fee (previous year Rs.Nil/-) received form wholly owned subsidiary company Pokarna Engineered Stone Limited.
- 6) The code on Social Security, 2020 ('code') relating to employee benefits received Presidential assent in September 2020. However, effective date and the final rules / interpretation have not yet been notified / issued. The company is on process of assessing the impact of Code and will recognize the impact, if any, based on its effective date.
- 7) Previous period / year figures have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary, to conform to current period's classification.

- 3) The figures of the quarter ended March 31, 2024 and March 31, 2023 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year up to March 31, 2024 and March 31, 2023 respectively and the unaudited published year to date figures up to December 31, 2023 and December 31, 2022 respectively, being the date of the end of the third quarter of the financial year. Also the figures up to the end of the third quarter had only been reviewed and not subjected to audit.
- 4) The Board of Directors of Pokarna Limited (Holding company) in its meeting held on 16th May, 2024 has recommended Equity Dividend @30% i.e. Rs.0.60 per equity share of Rs.2/- for the financial year 2023-24 (previous year Rs.186.02 lakhs @30% i.e., Rs.0.60 per equity share of Rs.2/- each), subject to requisite approvals. If approved, the dividend would result in a cash outflow of ₹186.02 lakhs.
- 5) The code on Social Security, 2020 ('code') relating to employee benefits received Presidential assent in September 2020. However, effective date and the final rules / interpretation have not yet been notified / issued. The group is on process of assessing the impact of Code and will recognize the impact, if any, based on its effective date
